

## Cutting

**House Roof** 

1-91/2" x 31/2" rectangle

House

2-5" squares

Chimneys

2-13/4" x 2" rectangles

Nine-Patches (dark/medium)

10-2" squares

Background

1-9½" x 3" rectangle

1-91/2" x 21/2" rectangle

2-31/2" squares


2-31/2" x 2" rectangles

8-2" squares

1-1" x 2" rectangle



Block 12 is 9" x 18" finished.






### Construction

Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.


Assemble the chimneys as shown.



# House Roof


2 House Root


Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-3½" background squares. Layer a 31/2" marked background square, right sides to together, on 1-9½" x 3½" roof rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 1.




# Nine-Patch Arrange 5–2" dark/medium squares and 4–2" background squares and 3 rows as shown. Join the

rows. Make 2 nine-patches.
