

Block 15 15½" x 18½" unfinished

Cutting

House Roof

1–14" x 7" rectangle 1–14" x 2¾" rectangle

House

1-6½" x 1¾" rectangle 2-2½" x 7¾" rectangles

Pinwheel Dark

2–378" squares cut in half once on the diagonal to make 4 half-square triangles

Pinwheel Light

2–3%" squares cut in half once on the diagonal to make 4 half-square triangles

Tree

1-6½" x 3½" rectangle 7-6½" x 2" rectangles

Tree Trunk

1-11/2" x 31/2" rectangle

Background

1–18½" x 2" rectangle 1–10½" x 2½" rectangle 1–6½" x 2" rectangle 2–7½" squares

2–3½" squares

2-3" x 3½" rectangles


2-23/4" squares

2-21/4" x 93/4" rectangles

14-2" squares



Block 15 is 15" x 18" finished.




Construction

Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

House

(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–2¾" background squares. Layer a 2¾" marked background square, right sides to together, on 1–14" x 2¾" roof rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the the opposite end of the same rectangle.









(B) Add a 14" x 7" roof rectangle.



(C) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–7½" background squares. Layer a 7½" marked background square, right sides to together, on roof rectangle from step B as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the the opposite end of the same rectangle.




(D) Join 1–3%" dark pinwheel HST and 1–3%" light pinwheel to make 1 half-triangle square (HTS). Make 4. Arrange and sew 2 rows of 2 HTS as shown. Join the rows to make the pinwheel.






Pinwheel 6½" x 6½" unfinished Make 1.


(E) Assemble the house as shown.








(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 14-2" background squares. Layer 2" marked background square, right sides to together, on $1-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 7.




(C) Assemble the tree as shown.
