6" or 12" Block Design by Carol Detloff for Thread Village®



Cutting for a 12" block:

BACKGROUND FABRIC

- A) 2 squares $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$
- B) 2 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$
- C) 2 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$
- D) 4 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$
- E) 2 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$

TREE FABRIC

- F) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 12\frac{1}{2}$
- G) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$
- H) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$
- J) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$
- K) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$

TREE TRUNK

- 1 square $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$

Sewing

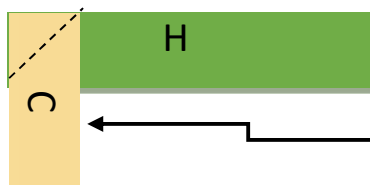
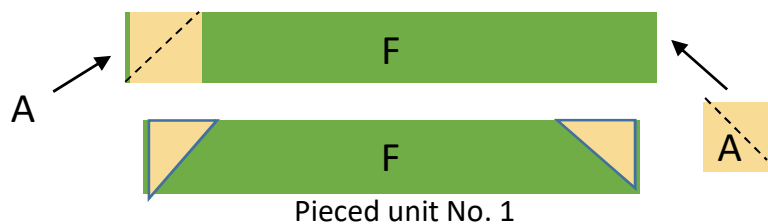
Draw diagonal line on wrong side of BACKGROUND square A. Place marked square on TREE print F strip, right sides together, aligning raw edges.

Stitch on drawn line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Open and press.

Repeat on the opposite end of strip to make pieced unit No. 1.

In same manner, match background pieces to tree pieces to make all 5 rows of tree. Assemble the bottom row using the tree trunk and 2 of the piece D strips using **straight** $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams.

Now stitch all 6 row units together to form your block.



For each row of your block:
Place background rectangles like this on each end of tree strips, draw diagonals, sew, trim & press open to complete each row



Cutting for a 6"x6" block

BACKGROUND FABRIC

- A) 2 squares $1\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$
- B) 2 rectangles $1\frac{1}{2} \times 2"$
- C) 2 rectangles $1\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$
- D) 4 rectangles $1\frac{1}{2} \times 3"$
- E) 2 rectangles $1\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$

TREE FABRIC

- F) $1\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$
- G) $1\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$
- H) $1\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$
- J) $1\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$
- K) $1\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$

TREE TRUNK

- 1 square $1\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$
