
### 1 Tree

(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–3½" background squares. Layer a 3½" marked background square, right sides to together, on 1–6½" x 3½ tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 1.





(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 10–2" background squares. Layer 2" marked background square, right sides to together, on 1–6½" x 2" tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 5.






Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 1–1½" background and 1–1½" mailbox roof squares. Layer a marked background square, right sides to together, on the 2½" x 4¼" mailbox front as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat using the marked 1½" mailbox square on the opposite corner as shown. Appliqué the circle to the front. Add a 2½" x 4¼" background rectangle as shown.



Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of  $4-3\frac{1}{2}$ " house squares and  $6-3\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares.

The same technique is used to make all the roof tops. Just note whether you are using a marked house or marked background square. Layer a marked square, right sides to together, on 1–6½" x 3½" roof rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle.

### 1 Tree

(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–3½" background squares. Layer a 3½" marked background square, right sides to together, on 1–6½" x 3½" tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 1.

(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8–2" background squares. Layer a 2" marked background square, right sides to together, on both ends of a 1–6½" x 2" tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal lines. Trim ¼" from the sewn lines. Press to reveal the triangles. Make 4.













### 7 House

(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–4¼" background squares. Layer a 4¼" marked background square, right sides to together, on 1–8" x 4½" roof rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 1.




(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8–21/4" star point squares. Layer 21/4" marked star point square, right sides to together, on 1–4" x 21/2" house rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 4 star points.




