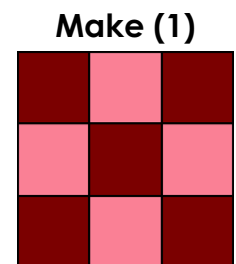
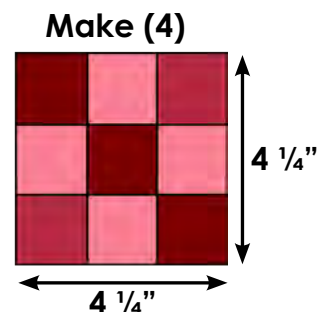
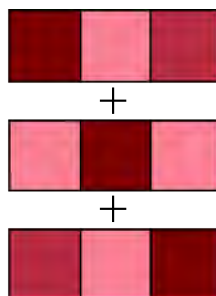
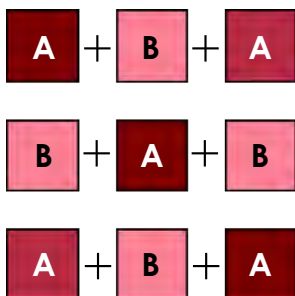


PLEASE NOTE: "A" cut pieces are shown using (2) fabrics. Plan fabric choices and adjust cutting accordingly.

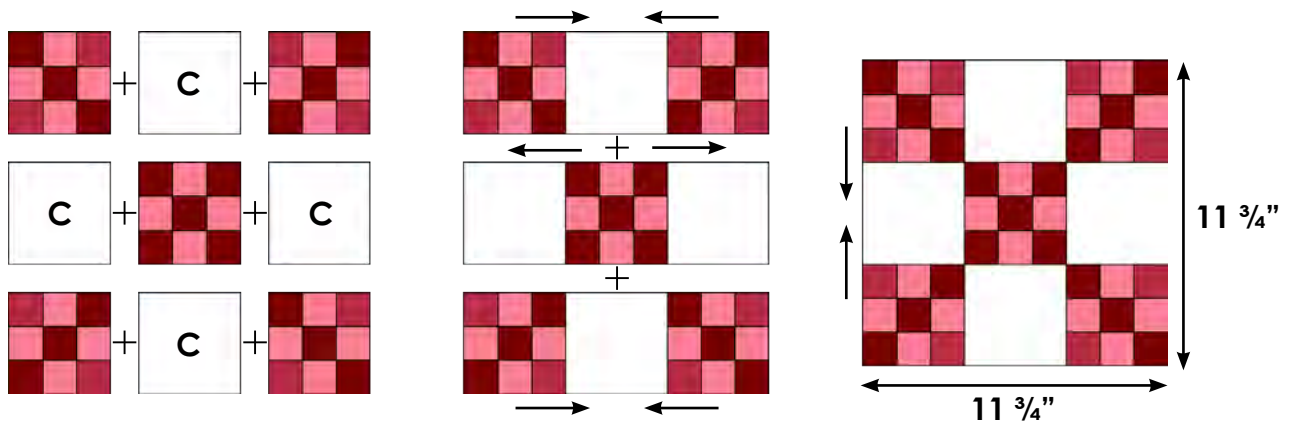
A	(25) 1 ¾" squares. <i>Grunge - 19 from 82, 6 from 328</i>
B	(20) 1 ¾" squares. <i>Grunge 30150-377</i>
C	(4) 4 ¼" squares. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
D	(1) 1 ¼" x 11 ¾" rectangle. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
E	(1) 1 ¼" x 12 ½" rectangle. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>

Assembly

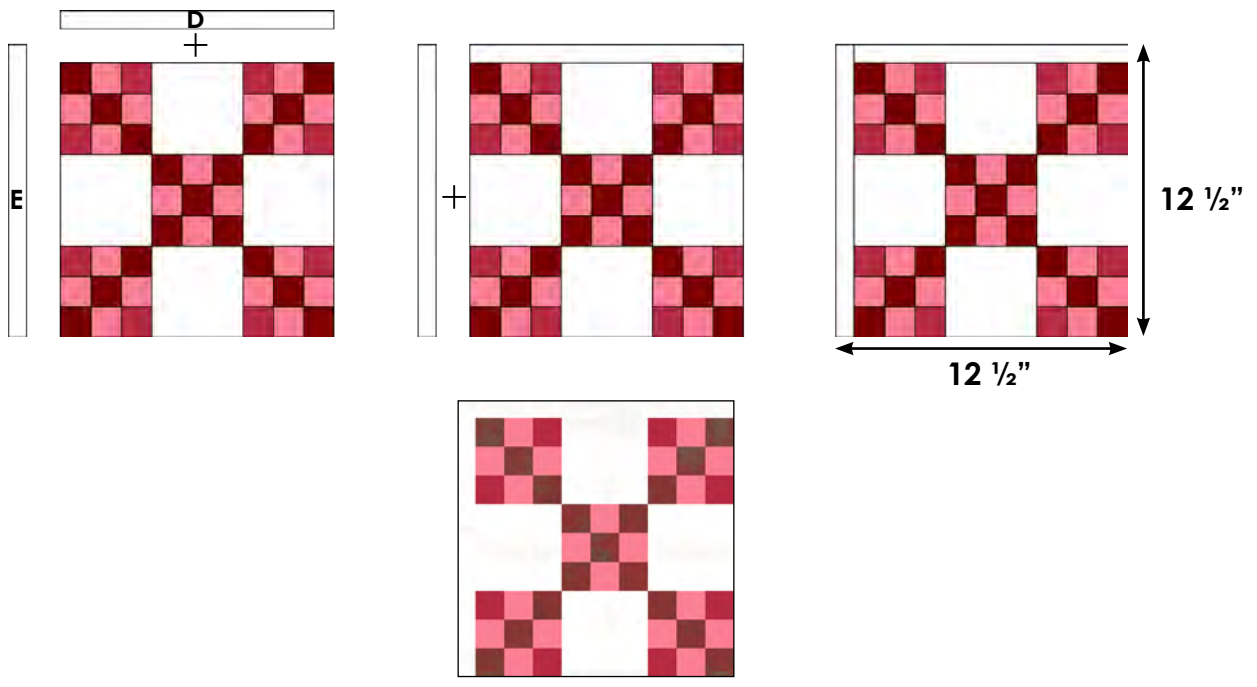
1. Make 9-patch units using (5) A squares and (4) B squares. Lay out squares as shown, alternating between fabrics. When sewing, press toward the darkest fabric.
2. Repeat to make (4) identical 9-patch units mixing A fabric prints. Make (1) 9-patch unit using (4) B squares and (5) matching A squares. 9-patch units should measure 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" unfinished.



- Place (5) 9-patch units and (4) C squares in a 3 x 3 grid as shown. Sew together in (3) horizontal rows pressing towards the C squares.
- Sew horizontal rows together and press toward the center row. Block should measure $11 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $11 \frac{3}{4}$ " at this step.



- Next sew (1) D rectangle to the top of the block. Press outward.
- Last sew (1) E rectangle to the left side of the block. Press outward to complete block assembly. Block should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
