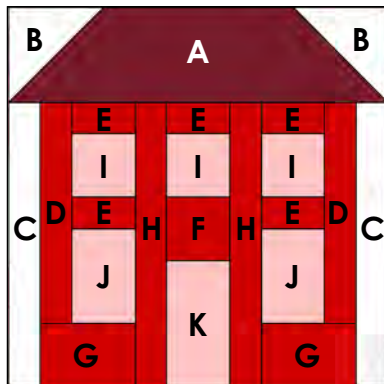


Cutting



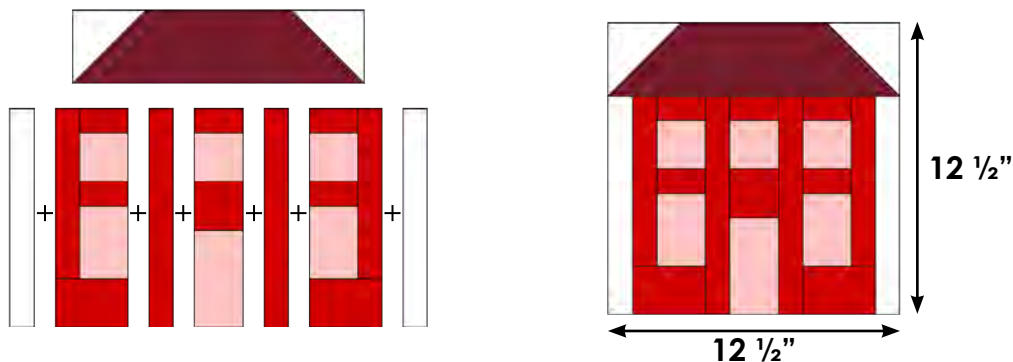
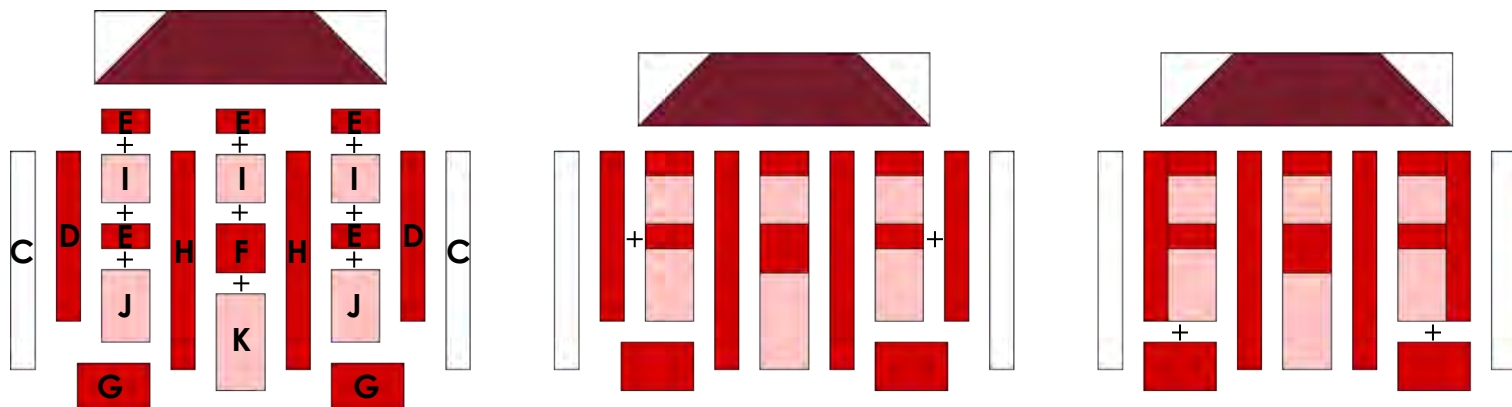
A	(1) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle. <i>Grunge 30150-82</i>
B	(2) 3 1/2" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
C	(2) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
D	(2) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles. <i>Grunge 30150-365</i>
E	(5) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. <i>Grunge 30150-365</i>
F	(1) 2 1/2" square. <i>Grunge 30150-365</i>
G	(2) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. <i>Grunge 30150-365</i>
H	(2) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. <i>Grunge 30150-365</i>
I	(3) 2 1/2" squares. <i>Grunge 30150-64</i>
J	(2) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. <i>Grunge 30150-64</i>
K	(1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle. <i>Grunge 30150-377</i>

Assembly

1. Create the roof for the house by placing (1) B square with a drawn diagonal line onto both corners of the A rectangle, right sides together and edges aligned. Diagrams show accurate B square placement.
2. Stitch along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim outermost excess fabric to 1/4". Press to the corner to complete the roof.



- Use the labeled diagram below to lay out the roof and remaining cut pieces C-K correctly. Follow the series of diagrams below to complete the house in stages. For all seams, press away from the windows, door, background and roof.
- Press to complete. Block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.
