

Cutting




PLEASE NOTE: Cut pieces C-G are shown using (2) different fabrics. Determine how many fabrics you wish to use and adjust cutting accordingly.	
Α	(1) 2 ½" square. <i>Grunge #30150 365</i>
В	(20) 1 ½" squares. <i>Grunge #30150 365</i>
С	(4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. <i>Grunge 2 ea. of 101 and 64</i>
D	(4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. <i>Grunge 2 ea. of 101 and 64</i>
E	(4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. <i>Grunge 2 ea. of 101 and 64</i>
F	(4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. <i>Grunge 2 ea. of 101 and 64</i>
G	(4) 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles. <i>Grunge 2 ea. of 101 and 64</i>

Assembly

- 1. Arrange A-B squares and C-G rectangles as shown in the diagrams.
- 2. Begin sewing the block together in layers, attaching rectangles to the block center in alphabetical order. For all layers, sew the side rectangles first. Then attach B squares to the top and bottom rectangles and sew. Press all seams toward the C-G rectangles and away from B squares.
- 3. Continue sewing until the block is complete. Block should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
