Repeat using the marked 1½" mailbox square on the opposite corner as shown. Appliqué the circle to the front. Add a 2½" x 4¼" background rectangle as shown.

The same technique is used to make all the roof tops. Just note whether you are using a marked house or marked background square. Layer a marked square, right sides to together, on  $1-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " roof rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle.
